Class Elevage

The Class Elevage [Breeder's Class] will consist of entries of a minimum of 3 dogs per team. You may include more dogs if you have them but there may be no more than five dogs per team. All dogs must have been produced by the same breeder but do not necessarily have to be related to each other (although that presumably could be highly likely); nor do they have to be currently owned by the breeder. The purpose of this class is to judge the CONSISTENCY of the dogs produced by that breeder. At least two of the 3 dogs must be entered in a regular class in the show. (Spayed or Neutered dogs may be included, but no more than one dog on a team of 3; or two dogs on a team of 4 or 5 may be altered.)

The teams will be separated by VARIETY although both varieties will compete in the same class, at the same time; but there is no distinction by sex so dogs of either or both sexes can be presented on a team. Therefore, a breeder could have more than one team entered; i.e. one team of all Orange and White dogs, and a second team of all "Other Color" dogs. If a breeder has a sufficient number of dogs in one variety (more than 5), they may enter more than one team per variety as long as each team has at least 3 dogs per team. Each team will be considered as a separate entry and will be judged separately.

Total Dog Award

To be eligible for this award, a dog must meet the requirements listed below.

- 1) Compete in conformation with competition and win one of the following classes:
 - a) Best Male/Female of Variety

- b) Best Male/Female
 - c) Best of Winners
 - d) Champion
 - e) Grand Champion
 - f) Best of Breed
- 2) Earn a qualifying score in a licensed class at a UKC Performance Event (Field Trial – Pass or higher)
- 3) Since there is no performance event the day of our specialty show, the UKC will allow us to use only one of the field trial days to be eligible for Total Dog, April 3rd, 2025 designated trial day to be coupled with the Show for Total Dog.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
2. CEB-US Reserves the right to refuse any and all entries
3. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC licensed event.
4. UKC, CEB-US, their agents, and employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC/CEB-US are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
5. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
6. No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such.
7. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
8. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
9. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
10. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or un-zippered crate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Show grounds will be open to exhibitors at 7:00 am. Overnight security is not provided, and no dog(s) may not be left on the grounds overnight.
2. All times are Eastern Standard Time.
3. No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such
4. No admission or parking fees.
5. Please clean up after yourself and your dogs

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

1. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC as Epagneul Bretons, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
2. An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

1. Entries may be submitted on the [Official UKC Entry Form](#) included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC Entry Form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of these forms may be used as well.
2. Advance entries may be mailed, scanned & emailed, or hand-delivered to the Show Secretary.
3. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.
4. **Advance entries must be postmarked by March 15, 2025**

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Advance Entry Fee (mail or hand-delivered) Entry Fee Licensed Classes -\$20; Junior Showmanship - \$5, Elevage-\$30
2. Advance Entry Deadline: Advance entries will be accepted by the Show Secretary Patty Lucasey until March 15, 2025 by mail.

4. **Day of Show entries will be accepted between the hours of 8:00 am –9:00 am, April 2, 2025. Day of Show fees: (Licensed Classes) - \$30; Jr. Show-\$5, Elevage \$40**

PAYMENT

1. Payment may be made by cash, check, or money order. No entry will be accepted without payment.
2. Make checks and money orders payable to CEB-US. Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. funds. Cash will be in US currency.
3. Post-dated checks or returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. CEB-US will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.

REFUNDS

1. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries canceled after the Advance Entry deadline.
2. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
3. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
4. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
5. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Written confirmation of entries will be made by email, as soon as practicable after receipt of Advanced Entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Saturday preceding this event, please notify the Show Secretary, Patty Lucasey at post7@ceb-us.com or (217)652-5430.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.
2. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.
3. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.

ARMBANDS

One armband will be assigned to each entered dog for all shows and trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. Armbands can be picked up at the Field Trial headquarters or from the Show Secretary on the day of the show. If you lose your armband or it gets destroyed, you can see the Show Secretary for a replacement.
